



TOUR OF THE VICTORIA FALLS

A natural phenomenon and one of the seven natural Wonders of the World, the Victoria Falls is an immense curtain of water cascading over a 100m drop. The volume is around 250 million cubic metres over the lip every minute, and at peak flow this increases to 550 million cubic metres. Around the Falls is a rainforest sustained by the spray of the Falls with some plant species rarely found elsewhere in Zambia or Zimbabwe. During peak flow (January to June) the Zambian side of the Falls is the most spectacular and there are walkways to look out points and across the Knife Edge bridge.

- ◆ If clients are staying at Sun International, they will be escorted by their guide from the hotel to the Falls. The walk is approximately 1km from the Royal Livingstone and approximately 200 metres from the Zambezi Sun.
